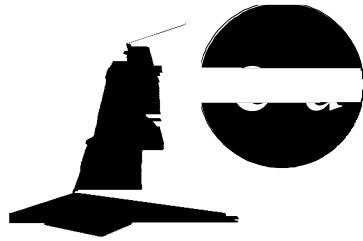


# University Ministry EU North Terrace July 2004



## 1. Some Background

Holy Trinity has supported the university work on North Terrace for many years. In partnership with AFES, we have sought to proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ to Adelaide Uni, and the City East and City West campuses of UniSA. The degree of our involvement is reflected in the level of resources that we have committed to this important ministry. In 2004, Geoff Lin, Kathy Fopp, Dave Brown, Mike Roe and Gemma Mayfield are all involved with EU North Terrace.

The aims of EU North Terrace for our students are simply stated:

1. Personal faith in Jesus Christ
2. Personal growth in godliness
3. Personal witness to Jesus Christ at home and abroad

## 2. The State of Play in 2004

We're currently in a state of transition between Senior Staffworkers. Warwick de Jersey oversaw this ministry during the last 10 years; following his return to Sydney, Geoff Lin has taken responsibility in 2004.

Thankfully, however, what ultimately matters is not the magnitude of our labour, but the providence of our God who changes lives – and so it's with great joy that we report that 2004 has (so far!) been a good year on campus.

We have around 150 students involved; but more than just numbers, there are a number of exciting stories about individuals whose lives are being changed. These range from new 1<sup>st</sup> years, to a growing presence in the colleges, to a deepening culture of evangelism amongst the students.

And that last remark is, of course, the primary reason for student work: to win the university for Christ. There are nearly 30,000 students on North Terrace who need to hear the gospel - let alone faculty and staff - and it's our privilege and responsibility, under God, to proclaim it to them!

## 3. On the Horizon

The 2 big events in the EU Calendar are fast approaching. The first is **Mid Year Conference (MYC)**, where EU goes away for a week to grow in Christian faith by studying the bible and praying together. This year we'll be focusing on Galatians, with the theme of "Free to Serve." If you can, please join us from 6-9pm on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> July at Adare Conference Site, Victor Harbour for a special Supporters night, and you can see for yourself what goes on!

The second is our annual **Mission** (held in mid-August) – when we focus all our resources on evangelizing the North Terrace campuses. This year's theme is The GodFather: "He's made you an offer you can't refuse."

## 4. F.Y.I

In response to feedback from a number of supporters, and in order to be as helpful as possible in the way that we communicate what's happening on campus, we're trialling some exciting new initiatives in 2004:

1. **Terrace Times** is our quarterly AFES newsletter. We'd love you to read it and pray through it! Email is best for us, but if that's not convenient, we'll still make paper copies available.

2. We've revised the frequency of our **prayer letter**. Rather than providing 3 months in advance, we're instead sending out 2-3 prayer points each week by email. If you don't have email, we still provide prayer points for each day of the week in Terrace Times. A huge thank-you to everyone who so faithfully remembers us in prayer already!

3. A number of Trinity members support university ministry **financially**. If you would like to do so, direct debits can be made via The Friends of Trinity Trust.
