## What is equip?

equip aims to be a training resource for South Australian Churches and Christian organisations. Its goal is to equip Christian people from all across the state for faithful and effective ministry. equip runs its subjects on **one weekend in March** and over **four Thursday nights in August** each year.

The diagram included in this brochure outlines some suggested equipping 'pathways'. Each pathway contains subjects that will equip you for a particular kind of ministry. You could choose to complete an entire pathway over a few years OR you could simply enrol in whatever subject appeals to you each time equip is run. Most subjects involve eight 50 minute sessions and will be offered at least once every two years.

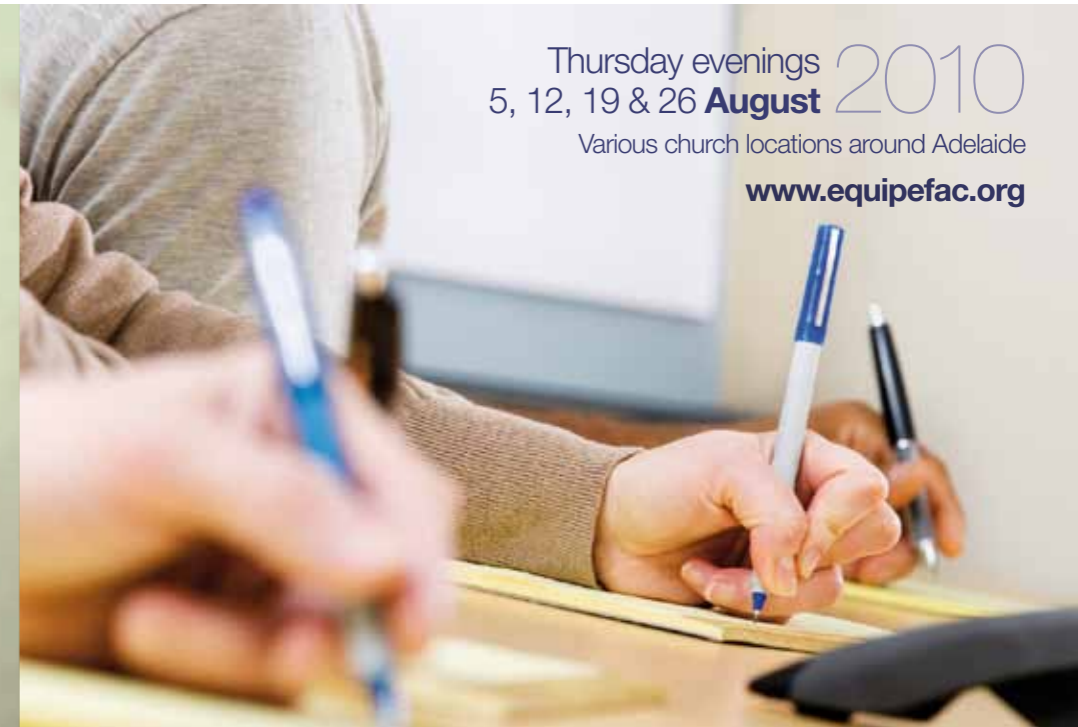
